6. THE GOOD THE BAD AND THE UGLY

- iPhone 'Screen Recording' function. Can be turned on in 'Settings', 'Control Centre', 'Customise Controls'. Works with or without sound but the benefit of sound is that it records the environment, not just the sounds the phone is making, therefore you can verbally give instructions too. Can also use it to give feedback on recordings you have taken etc.
