

Letter Size and Position on the Line

TIP #1

Draw or trace blue (sky), green (grass) and brown (dirt) lines on writing paper. This can help your child with sizing of letters and positioning of letters on the line, e.g. 'h' starts in the sky (blue) and sits on the dirt (brown).

TIP #2

Show your child how to position tall, small and tail letters on the lines:

- Tall letters up to the sky or top dotted line
- Small letters up to the grass or lower dotted line
- Tail letters with tail 'digging' under the dirt or bottom line.

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TIP #4

Aim for frequent practise in short bursts. Take a break to stretch and move when needed.

TIP #3

Have your child copy words or sentences and ask them to find and circle letters which are positioned correctly on the line/s.
