## 6. THE GOOD THE BAD AND THE UGLY

- Hydrosense – a mat that goes over a mattress that is designed to manage and maintain a comfortable temperature. It circulates water, and allows remote control adjustment of the temperature of the water. Sue has trialled with two clients (one child, one adult) who have found it very useful. The temperature can be set as low as 20 degrees or as high as 37. May be of interest if you have vigilant or reliable caregivers for the children you are working with, to monitor
