### WORDS THAT **EMPHASIZE** UNCERTAINTY. **POSSIBILITY &** ALTERNATIVES

maybe, might perhaps, possibly sometimes, not sure, almost

VERBS 쑭 think, hope, remember, forget, decide, wish, wonder, know, don't know, imagine

COGNITIVE

# Maybe your friend wants to play too. We might go outside later.

And always use a **GIVE over GET** mindset.

#### OBSERVATIONAL WORDS OR WORDS RELATED TO OUR SENSES

🐅 notice, see, hear, smell, feel

I notice everyone is ready for our story. I heard your friend ask you something. I can tell your friend feels happy!

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#### MINDEUL PACING

- It's really important to give everyone time to think.
  - Pause so your learner can respond in their own unique way.
- Don't be afraid of silence!
